VINEYARD

The Home Ranch vineyard is on the east side of Dry Creek and has been farmed by the Sbragia family for decades. The Schmidt Ranch, farmed by my friends, Janice and Brian Schmidt, has been in their family since 1876.

VINTAGE

The growing season in Dry Creek Valley was nearly magical. Cool nights, foggy mornings and warm sunny days throughout summer and into harvest ripened a crop that was notable for both quality and quantity.

WINEMAKING

To emphasize the brightness and clarity of the fruit, we ferment the grapes in 100% stainless steel. The wine is placed in seasoned barrels until bottling in January and released with a screw cap closure that protects the bouquet and bright flavors.

WINEMAKER NOTES

Citrus and tropical aromas are accented by succulent flavors of green apple, grapefruit and lemongrass, and a lovely minerality that carries into a long, crisp, refreshing finish. Altogether delicious!
