Sbragia is producing five separate Cabernet Sauvignons, and the in-the-bottle notes that follow demonstrate that each of them performed better from the bottle than it did last year from barrel. The finest offering yet from his project with San Francisco 49er hall-of-fame quarterback, Joe Montana, the 2007 Cabernet Sauvignon Montagia (a blend of 95% Cabernet Sauvignon and 5% Cabernet Franc) is superb. From Howell Mountain and Mt. Veeder vineyards, it reveals sumptuous aromas of graphite, boysenberries, blueberries and black currants, a perfumed style, an opulent, full-bodied mouthfeel and admirable purity as well as depth. This beauty can be drunk now or cellared for 20+ years. To the credit of both Sbragia and Montana, much of this wine is donated to charitable foundations.

Wine Access

Deep ruby-red. Very ripe aromas of blackberry, blueberry, dark chocolate and mocha, accented by dried herbs. Concentrated and lively in the mouth, with surprising harmonious acidity framing the flavors of cassis, blueberry, dark chocolate and minerals. A leafy note adds nuance to the finish, which is suave and precise. In a rather elegant style in the context of this set of cabernets but with no lack of structure or strength.
