2012 MONTE ROSSO VINEYARD CABERNET SAUVIGNON *Moon Mountain District | Sonoma Valley*

VINEYARD: Monte Rosso | Heritage Site | Planted 1880s

VARIETAL: 95% Cabernet Sauvignon, 4% Cabernet Franc, 1% Petite Verdot

HARVEST: October 10-22, 2012

COOPERAGE: Aged 24 months in new French Nevers oak barrels.

ALC: 14.8% **TA:** 6.22 gm/L **pH:** 3.66

CASES PRODUCED: 1,197

WINEMAKER NOTES

My good friend, Mike Martini, whose family bought Monte Rosso in the late 1930s, shares a couple of blocks with me every year. At 1,200 feet elevation, this is a classic mountain vineyard, resting firmly on the southwest side of the Mayacamas mountain range. Sitting above the fog line, the vineyard's iron-rich soils are red, rocky and well drained. The old, head-pruned vines struggle for nutrients and the rich, concentrated fruit shows it.
